

RESOLUTION NO. 2014- 35

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CITY PROPERTY FOR THE
PLACEMENT OF WEATHER WARNING SIRENS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
EXECUTE EASEMENTS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, Drew County has obtained a grant for the installation of weather warning sirens in Drew County including in the City of Monticello;

Whereas, The City of Monticello has agreed to participate in this project pursuant prior enactments of Monticello City Counsel;

Whereas, the sites for the sirens have been determined;

Whereas, the location of the sites for the sires within the City of Monticello are located on real property owned by City of Monticello;

Whereas, Drew County has requested City of Monticello to consent to the installation of sirens and to execute an easement for that purpose.

It is, therefore, by the City Council of Monticello, Arkansas resolved as follows:

1. That consent is hereby granted to the installation and maintenance of weather warning sirens at the following locations owned by The City of Monticello, to wit:

1. Monticello Fire Training Center;
2. Country Club Water Tower;
3. Western Pines Park;
4. Old Troy Road Water Tower; and
5. Monticello Sports Complex.

The exact location of the area to be determined by survey.

2. That the Mayor is authorized to execute an easement to Drew County for the purpose of the installation and maintenance of said weather warning sirens.

3. An emergency is declared to exist and this resolution being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of Monticello shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage.
