

RESOLUTION NO. 17-42

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MONTICELLO TO
CHANGE THE NAME OF THAT PORTION OF SOUTH BOYD STREET
BETWEEN WEST JACKSON AND WEST RAILROAD AVENUE AND ALSO
WEST RAILROAD AVENUE BETWEEN CHESTER STREET AND SOUTH
BOYD STREET TO SHAY GILLESPIE STREET

Whereas, Ronald "Shay" Gillespie is a long time resident of the City of Monticello and the City Council of Monticello deems it appropriate to recognize the significant contributions of Ronald "Shay" Gillespie to the City of Monticello and, particularly, the youth of the City of Monticello;

Whereas, it is determined by the City Council of Monticello, Arkansas that an appropriate expression of appreciation and recognition for Ronald "Shay" Gillespie is the renaming of that portion of South Boyd Street between West Jackson and West Railroad Avenue and also West Railroad Avenue between Chester Street and South Boyd Street to Shay Gillespie Street.

It is, therefore, by the City Council of Monticello, Arkansas resolved as follows:


1. That the portion of South Boyd Street between West Jackson and West Railroad Avenue and also West Railroad Avenue between Chester Street and South Boyd Street in the City of Monticello shall be changed to Shay Gillespie Street.

2. That this change shall be implemented, effective immediately, pursuant to the emergency clause to be passed consistent with this resolution. The Mayor and the City Street Department are directed to implement this resolution by the acquisition of street signs to declare to the public the renaming of that portion of South Boyd Street between West Jackson and West Railroad Avenue and also West Railroad Avenue between Chester Street and South Boyd Street to Shay Gillespie Street as well as making such changes in the City's internal records, maps and to communicate the same as reasonably necessary to all parties to include the United States Postal Service.

3. That an emergency is declared to exist and this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
