RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR GRANT FOR PURCHASE AND OUTFITTING OF POLICE UNITS AND APPLICATION OF GRANT FROM UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO APPLY TOWARD COST OF ACQUISITION AND OUTFITTING OF POLICE VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the City of Monticello has the opportunity to apply for and receive a \$50,000.00 grant from the United States Department of Agriculture for the purpose of outfitting one previously purchased police unit with technology and for the purchase of a four (4) police units and outfitting them with technology all for a total cost of \$158,400.00;


WHEREAS, the acquisition of the four (4) new police units and the outfitting of those new units together with a unit previously purchased with updated technology is in the best interest of the City of Monticello.

IT IS, THEREFORE, by the Monticello City Council resolved as follows:


1. That the City of Monticello is authorized to apply for USDA grant of \$50,000.00 toward the acquisition of four (4) new police units and the outfitting of those four (4) units together with the unit purchased last year with technology and the Mayor is authorized and directed to complete said application process.
2. Upon the grant being approved the City of Monticello is authorized to purchase four (4) new police units and outfit the same with technology and to outfit one (1) previously purchased unit with said technology at a total cost (exclusive of the grant reimbursement) of \$158,400.00.
3. That the purchase of the police units is part of the State's bid program and, therefore, the advertisement for bids is not required.
4. That the cost of outfitting each unit is \$7,935.00 per unit. That cost is authorized by the City Council.
