

RESOLUTION NO. 22-23

**A RESOLUTION TO ADDRESS PREMIUM PAY FOR CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, the American Rescue Plan Act "ARPA," provides fiscal relief funds to state and local governments and other program areas aimed at mitigating the continuing effects of the pandemic and it provides for four eligible use funding categories including the ability to provide Premium Pay and other pay for certain eligible city workers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Monticello City Council adopted Resolution 21-70 on December 9, 2021, to provide for Premium Pay or bonuses and this included members of the city council and/or the Mayor; and

**WHEREAS**, on Thursday, January 6, 2022, the United States Treasury published the ARPA Final Rule with Commentary which clarifies that the Uniform Grant Guidelines (UGG) and the Award Terms and Conditions do not permit City Council members and/or Mayors to receive any Rescue grant funds because of UGG's conflict of interest provisions; and


**WHEREAS**, this funding has already been paid.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Monticello Council, that:

The City Council directs the finance director to move the expenditures for the Premium Pay and the applicable employer contributions for the Mayor and City Council members in the total amount of \$3902.19 from the General Fund to the ARPA fund and the city hereby amends the budgets to reflect the changes.


