RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BODY CAMERAS FOR MONTICELLO POLICE DEPARTMENT  
THROUGH THE SMALL RURAL AND TRIBAL COMMUNITY BODY WORN CAMERA PROGRAM  
FEDERAL GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Monticello Police Department has been awarded a Federal Grant through the Small Rural and Tribal Community Body Worn Camera Program in the amount of \$8,499.79;

WHEREAS, the Monticello Police Department applied for the grant in the amount of \$8,499.79 with the intent to purchase (21) Body Cameras for Patrol and Criminal Investigation Division Officers (Reso No 22-33 dated 4-26-22);

WHEREAS, acquisition of such equipment for the Monticello Police Department through the Small Rural and Tribal Community Body Worn Camera Program (Federal Grant) is in the best interest of the City of Monticello.


IT IS THEREFORE, by the City Council of Monticello, Arkansas, resolved as follows:

1. That the City is authorized to purchase (21) Body Cameras for the purchase price of \$10,499.79 with said purchase price to be partially reimbursed in the amount of \$8,499.79 through the Small Rural and Tribal Community Body Worn Camera Program (Federal Grant)
2. The Grant Revenue will be receipted into General Fund Budgeted Revenue Line Item #4991 Federal Grants
3. The Purchase of Body Cameras will be expended from General Fund Police Department Budgeted Expense Line Item #5202 Supplies

IT IS, THEREFORE, by the Monticello City Council resolved as follows:


