AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING AROUND
THE CITY SQUARE, SETTING PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATION, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that parking of vehicles around the City Square often creates a detriment to traffic flow, especially when the vehicles parked are being used for commercial purposes, thereby encouraging other vehicles to stop, adding to the hazard; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles detract from the appearance of the square which has always been regarded as a beautiful asset for the City:


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MONTICELLO, ARKANSAS as follows:

Section 1. Effective January 1, 2004, no person shall be permitted to park or otherwise situate any vehicle or other conveyance in any location adjacent to the City Square, at any time.


Section 2. For any first violation of this ordinance, the violator shall be issued a warning by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce traffic regulations in the City of Monticello. For any second violation, the violator shall be issued a citation and shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$50.00. For any third or subsequent violation of this ordinance, the violator shall be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$100.00.

Section 3. Repealer. That any ordinance or part thereof in conflict with this ordinance shall be deemed repealed to the extent of such conflict.
