

ORDINANCE NO. 731

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 445  
OF THE CITY OF MONTICELLO TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVY OF  
A FEE FOR PLUMBING INSPECTIONS MADE AFTER REGULAR  
BUSINESS HOURS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 445 of the City of Monticello, Arkansas was enacted on July 9, 1965, specifically adopting the Arkansas State Plumbing Code and providing for the assessment of fees for the service of inspection of plumbing work; and

WHEREAS, Said Ordinance No. 445 was amended by Ordinance No. 541 of the City of Monticello; and

WHEREAS, it has been found that inspections done after regular working hours subjects the City to overtime expenses:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Monticello, Arkansas, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 445 of the City of Monticello, as previously amended, be and the same is hereby, amended to add subsection (d), which shall read as follows:

" Section 4. Applications; Permits; Fees.

"d. When an inspection is requested after regular business hours, an additional charge of \$25.00 shall be added to the regular fee charged for plumbing inspections. "Regular business hours" shall be defined as the between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The fee shall be charged for any inspection performed after the stated hours or if performed on Saturday, Sunday or any holiday which is observed by closing of the City offices.

If an inspection is requested during regular working hours and the City Plumbing Inspector is unable to make the inspection during regular working hours, the inspection shall be made during business hours on the next day City offices are open during regular working hours."

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 3. Severability. The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance or of the code hereby adopted shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

Section 4. Emergency clause. This ordinance is necessary for the provision of funds to appropriately compensate City employees for work performed after hours to inspect plumbing work which is necessary for sanitation purposes. An emergency is therefore declared to exist, and this ordinance, being immediately necessary for the preservation and protection of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
