

ORDINANCE NO. 750

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BID PROCEDURE TO ALLOW FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO A CITY WASTE WATER TREATMENT FACILITY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 446 of the City of Monticello established the purchasing procedures for the City of Monticello, which ordinance has been subsequently amended by ordinances no. 559, 621, 696-A (codified as 697) and 741 of the City of Monticello; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid ordinances authorize the Mayor to expend up to the sum of \$20,000.00 without the necessity of invitation for competitive bidding thereon; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Ann. § 14-58-303 (b)(2)(A)(iii) authorizes cities of the first class to waive any bid requirement where such is not feasible or practical;

WHEREAS, the Mayor has advised the City Council of urgent and emergency repairs that are necessary for the continued operation of the City's waste water treatment facility located north of the City Airport;

WHEREAS, the City of Monticello deems it necessary and appropriate to waive any bid requirements and allow the Mayor to contract directly for the immediate repair of said waste water treatment facility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Monticello, Arkansas as follows:

Section 1. That the City waste water treatment facility located north of the City Airport is in immediate need of urgent and emergency repairs that are necessary for the continued operation of said facility.

Section 2. That pursuant to Arkansas Code Ann. § 14-58-303 (b)(2)(A)(iii), the necessity for procuring competitive bids for the repair of the City water treatment facility located north of the City Airport should be, and are, waived.

Section 3. That the Mayor of Monticello is hereby authorized and directed to take any and all such action as is necessary for the immediate repair of the City waste water treatment facility located north of the City Airport and to execute any documentation connected therewith.

Section 4. Any other ordinances or resolutions of the City in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Whereas there is an immediate and urgent need to repair the City waste water treatment facility located north of the City Airport; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance, being immediately necessary for the preservation and protection of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
