

RESOLUTION NO. RS-2015-14

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2015
ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET; ALLOWING
RECEIPT OF A FEDERAL POLICE
TECHNOLOGY IMPROVEMENT GRANT.**

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the 2015 Budget, the U.S. Department of Justice has selected the City of Monticello Police Department to qualify for a 100%/no-match grant for technology improvements through the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program for the amount of \$4,200.00; and

WHEREAS, at the request Monticello Police Chief Eddie Deaton, the Mayor has determined the best utilization of the grant funds are to apply for funding to purchase eighteen body-worn patrol cameras.

WHEREAS, body camera systems will increase transparency and accountability of city police officers; while protecting them from false accusations by residents.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the Monticello, Arkansas that the 2015 Adopted Operating Budget referenced in Resolution 2015-08 be amended as follows:


1. In the General Fund, a budgeted revenue account be created for "Federal Grants" for the amount of \$4,200.00 dollars:

2. In the General Fund, Police Department, a budgeted expense account be created for "Machinery & Equipment Outlay" for the amount of \$4,232.00 dollars:

5702 Machinery & Equipment Outlay \$4,232.00
